High Vocational Innovation Scholarship?



We recognize the value and potential of high vocational graduates as they play a key role in developing and sustaining manufacturing industries and the economy. Thus, the 'High Vocational Innovation Scholarship Program' is established based on that recognition to provide free scholarships to children from the country's 20% lowest income households to allow them to further study in the vocational field, which is highly demanded in the labor market.
